You may have heard or may even have seen some changes going on in the building.

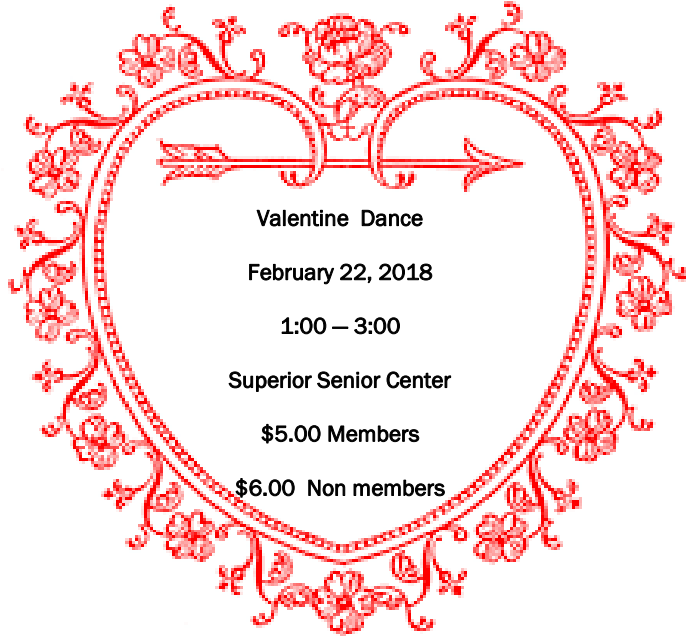
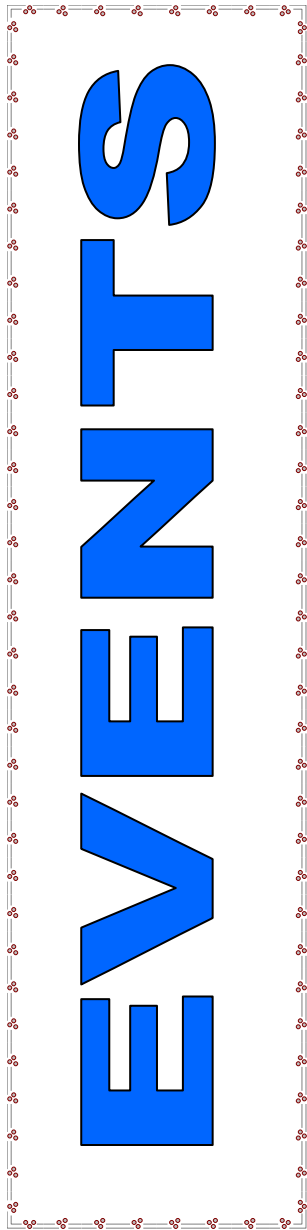
We have been approved by the City to get all the handicap buttons fixed, and a new door for the back of the building .
